Welcome back to the Autumn term at Corvedale! We have 18 pupils in our class this year, made up of children from Year 4 and Year 5.

Miss Ebrey and Miss Price have lots of exciting lessons and activities planned for Class 3 this term, including our trip to Wilderhope on September 28th – 29th.

History

Our History topic this term will examine the changes between the Stone Age and the Iron Age. The children will look at various aspects of life during this time period, including food and housing. After half term our topic will change to a more Geography based question of ‘Why is it so dangerous to live on the west coast of America?’



Art

This term, Art will be directly linked to our History topic of the Stone Age to the Iron Age, covering a range of techniques using varying resources and influences.



Science

Our Science topic this term is Sound. After half term we will look at Animals including humans – healthy hearts. Children are encouraged to bring in any of their own books or research from home. This term we will be using our new ‘Big Books’ to record our Science work.

RE

In RE we will be focusing on Judaism and Christianity. We will think about the questions: ‘How special is the relationship Jews have with God?’ and ‘What is the most significant part of the Nativity story for Christians today?’

PE

PE lessons are scheduled for **Monday and Friday** each week. Our lessons will be held outside (weather permitting) so your child may prefer long trousers for these lessons in cold weather. Children must have a complete change of clothes for PE. If kit is not in school for two sessions, we will contact you to discuss the situation. Please send a note if your child is not able to take part in PE lessons.

Reading Records

We have reading time every day in school. This includes guided sessions with staff, comprehension activities, target tasks and independent reading. Please continue to encourage your child to read at home and record their reading and any comments in the log books. Children should be reading their Accelerated Reader books whenever possible and then quizzing on these books in school.

Our PSHE topic this term is ‘Being healthy’ where children will look at how food, exercise and lifestyle can affect our health and fitness levels. After half term we will focus on ‘Saying NO to bullying.’

Miss Ebrey will be teaching the class French this term on Wednesday mornings. We will look at travel, sports, weather, traditional stories and life in France.

On Wednesday afternoons children will work with other pupils across the school in House Activities. These sessions will include Forest Schools, Art, Music and Drama activities.
