Geography / History

In Geography this term we will continue to think about: 'What makes the Earth angry?' We will use some of the information we gather on volcanoes and earthquakes to complete our information texts in Literacy. After half term we will move on to our new History topic of 'The Romans.'



Art

This term, Art will be linked to our Geography and History topics, covering a range of techniques using varying resources and influences.



Science

Our Science topics this term are HEALTHY HEARTS and EARTH AND SPACE. These lessons will take place on Tuesday afternoons. Children are encouraged to bring in any of their own books, artefacts or research from home. This term we will continue to use our 'Big Books' to record our Science work.

RE

In RE we will be focusing on Judaism and Christianity. We will think about the questions: 'How important is it for the Jewish people to do what God asks them to do?' and 'Did God intend Jesus to be crucified?'

PE

PE lessons are scheduled for **Thursday and Friday** each week. The Friday lessons will be held outside (weather permitting) so your child may prefer long trousers for these lessons in cold weather. Children must have a complete change of clothes for PE. Please send a note in to school if your child is unable to take part in PE lessons for any reason.

Reading

We have reading time every day in school. This includes guided sessions, comprehension activities, target tasks and independent reading. Please continue to encourage your child to read at home and record their reading and any comments in their Reading Records. Children should be reading their Accelerated Reader books whenever possible and then quizzing on these books in school.

Our PSHE topics this term are 'Being healthy' and 'Friendships.' Year 5 children will also be introduced to the Shropshire Respect Yourself programme later this term as part of our RSE teaching.

Miss Ebrey will be teaching the class French this term on Wednesday mornings. We will look at likes and dislikes, money, French stories and general conversation, with a focus on grammar.

On Wednesday afternoons children will work with other pupils across the school in House Activities. These sessions will include Forest Schools, Art, Music and Drama activities.
