<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Code of Practice: Arrangements for beginning and end of the school day</u></p> <p>In order to keep our children safe, everyone who uses the school site between 8.30 - 9.00am and 3.00 - 3.45pm should follow this code of practice.</p> <p>Vehicle movement around the site: If you bring or collect your child by car you must not park on the zig zag lines. Parking on these lines makes it very difficult to access the site and makes crossing the road more difficult for pedestrians. It is also illegal!</p> <p>The area beside the village hall should be left clear to allow the school buses to access the site. When parking in front of the hall please be aware of any pedestrians in the area when moving away.</p> <p>All other cars should be parked on Mill Lane, with due attention to the needs of other road users and respect for our neighbours.</p> <p><u>Supervision arrangements:</u> We have a duty to supervise children from 8.45am. We cannot accept children before this time. The staff on duty open doors at 8.45am to allow entry. Children who arrive by bus before 8.45am will be let in to school.</p> <p>Our school day ends at 3.15pm. Children who travel home by bus will be taken to transport waiting on the school playground to allow them to leave site promptly.</p> <p>Children who walk or who are collected by car will be released as soon as buses have left the site.</p> <p>Each class takes a home-time register every morning. This allows Mrs Jones to draw up individual registers for bus, club and walker queues, and to check arrangements for children who are unsure about home-time collection.</p> <p>It is important that <u>parents contact school as early as possible when arrangements are different from normal in any way</u>. You can send a note with your child or phone the office.</p>
