I would like to invite parents and carers to what I hope to be useful sessions on mathematics. The aim of them will be to enable you as parents to understand the mathematics being a taught to your child through primary school thus enabling you to better assist with your child's learning.

Each session will hopefully be informative with knowledge of what the children are learning and when. Also there will be a brief insight in to how they are taught it with methods, such as calculation methods, explained and resources shared. In addition there could be ideas how parents can help their child continue their learning outside of school.

Our first session will be on Tuesday 3rd October at 6:30pm, when the theme will be Number Sense and Number Bonds. We will cover: What do we mean by number sense? What is a number bond and how do we teach them?

If this proves successful we intend to run similar sessions throughout the year, perhaps once a month. Future topics will include: Multiplication & long division; Fractions decimals & percentages; Addition & subtraction; Money; Time; Algebra; Measures; Powers of 10 and Converting units. They will hopefully coincide with topics being covered in school at that particular time of year.

You are welcome to choose one, several or all of the topics.

I will send out a separate invite letter with return slip next week. Please look out for this and return the slip this will enable us to prepare resources etc.


Headlice
