Update from Mr Brough

The aim is for them to be 'next year ready' when we start again in September. But make sure they (and yourselves) have a bit of a break!! School will be closed for the holidays however we are hoping to have some much-needed decorating done in the two classrooms at the front of the school.

Plans for the September return are slowly developing. You may have seen the guidance from government earlier this week. At this moment in time, we do intend to open fully in the first week of September with some semblance of normality. Our classes will be Reception and Y1 with Mrs Rook; Y2 and Y3 with Mrs Condra; Y4 and Y5 with Mrs Littlar and Y6 with Mr Brough. There was very little response from you and as the demand was very low, we are not continuing with these plans, but we will contact individually those who responded to make some arrangements.
