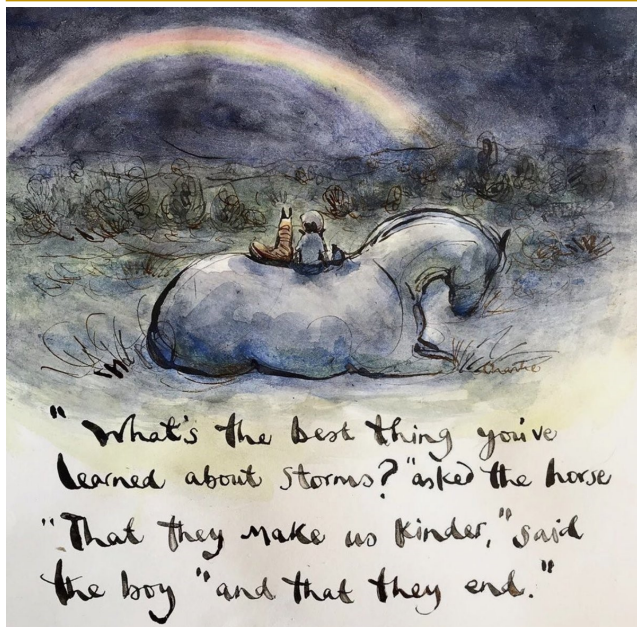
Corvedale Centre for Children
