School Payments Now Online!

Last week your child will have brought home an online access letter for the schools new payment system SCOPAY. This has all the information and codes required to access your child's online payment account. This is the same system that is used at many other schools (including Ludlow Secondary School) So if you already have set up a SCOPAY account, you only need to add your child's code when you log in, and you then will be able to view all your children's accounts in one place.

Paying for Dinners, afterschool clubs, school uniform and trips & events will all be available on this system going forward. Should you require access for more than one parent or carer, please request this from Mrs Pote, as multiple access details are possible for each child, we simply need to generate another access letter.
