Home Learning Policy Statement

Introduction:

The school will respond to a suspected case of Covid 19 by following the guidance from Public Health England and advice from the local Public Health Panel. The advice could include instructing bubbles of pupils to stay home for 14 days. In these circumstances the plan is to provide for learning at home.

The teachers have produced a home learning plan for the school, and this has been agreed at a full staff meeting and these plans will be in place for the Autumn term 2020.

Home Learning plan for all classes

In the event of a child needing to self-isolate, we would ask them to complete the following learning at home every day if they are well. Please also use the useful links on the school website to explore other home learning options.

Reading (20 mins daily) = Reading aloud and sharing books together will help your reading improve. Please use your school home reading books or your own books to read every day.

Phonics (Year R, 1 & 2, 10 mins daily) = The homework pack has phonics information to support home learning. You can also access free games on phonicsplay.co.uk to practise phases 3-5

Spelling (Year 3, 4, 5, & 6, 10 mins daily) = Spelling shed assignments refresh weekly and are linked to the homework pack spelling sheets.

Writing (20 mins daily) = Practising writing is important. You can practise your handwriting by copying out writing from a book. You could do some news writing, create a story, write a poem or write some instructions. Please write every day. In the event of a lengthy lockdown Home Learning units from Pathways to Write will be used.

Grammar and punctuation (Year 3, 4, 5, & 6, 10 mins daily) = Use the CGP books sent home in the Summer term to practice skills.

Maths Number Facts (20 mins daily) = You can use NumberGym Bond Builder, Table Trainer and/or Mental Maths Challenge in addition to Maths Shed for number facts practice as well as completing the homework pack KIRFs sheets. Year 3 - 6 s can also use the CGP books sent home in the Summer term to practice skills

Maths Mastery (40 mins daily) = Please watch the White Rose Maths home learning video and complete the premium resources worksheets which will be emailed to you.

Twice weekly phone call – to those children who have limited internet to ensure they are engaging with the home learning. Head or Class teacher

The teacher will provide a weekly email greeting and explanation of the learning. This will also be available through the class pages on the school website.

Home Learning plan for the for children who are unable to access a computer or the internet.

Children will be sent weekly packs of work that will include 3 daily activities.

The work will mirror the activities online as closely as possible.

Daily reading with parents will be encouraged - parents will post evidence instead of signing diaries.

Additions

The school appreciates that parents are doing a great job at home during these extraordinary times and they know their children best so we encourage activities that interests and motivates them to learn. We also encourage parents and children to share what they have been doing and of course, to ask any questions
