Summary.

- 1.Overall the % of excellent /good responses has stayed constant but there has been an increase in a move to good rather than excellent responses.
- 2.Homework still remains an area to look at
- 3.The variety of extra curricular activities needs looking at and the people/resources needed to deliver it.
- 4.There is still an overwhelming number of parents (95-97%) who view what the school offers as either excellent or good. The “needs improvement” except for homework and extra curricular activities is largely equivalent to one parents response.
5. 97% of our parents would still recommended our school to other parents and feel that it is a safe and happy place to learn with 100% endorsing that their children are making good progress and 97% believing that good behaviour is promoted.
