# Summary.

- 1.Overall the % of excellent /good responses has stayed constant but there has been an increase in a move to excellent rather than good responses.
- 2. Homework still remains an area to look at but needs improving has gone down
- 3. The variety of extra curricular activities still needs looking at and the people/resources needed to deliver it especially for younger children.
- 4.It must still be noted that the SEND figures reflect the Ofsted parents responses and possibly their comments.
- 5.There is still an overwhelming number of parents (95-100%) who view what the school offers overall as either excellent or good. The "needs improvement" including homework and extra curricular activities is largely equivalent to one or two parents responses.
- 6. The leadership of the school and its relationship with parents is still at 100%.
- 7. 100% of our parents would still recommended our school to other parents and feel that it is a safe and happy place to learn with 98% endorsing that their children are making good progress and 96% believing that good behaviour is promoted.
